Bishop Jonathan will be coming to Holy Trinity for the first time to celebrate the 7.30 pm Mass on Tuesday evening 6th June. He will be staying for some drinks and light refreshments after the Mass and a chance to meet members of the PCC and other people in the congregation. All welcome.

A WEEK OF ACCOMPANIED PRAYER

You are invited to take part in the Week of Accompanied Prayer which takes place over the week Sunday 11th June to Sunday 18th June. The week is intended to help people develop their prayer by experiencing it in the middle of their everyday life, within the normal routine of their work, family and other commitments.

Every day those participating are asked to set aside about 30 minutes for personal prayer, taking account of their individual situation. Some people use this time praying at home, others take part of their lunchtime praying in a church near their work, or come into our own church to pray. Participants will also meet daily with a Prayer Guide in a quiet space at Hornsey Parish Church for 30 minutes each day Monday-Friday. This confidential meeting gives them the opportunity to talk about their prayer and how this relates to their whole faith life.

The Prayer Guides have received training in helping others in prayer. Their role is mainly to listen to the participants, encouraging them to honour their prayer and learn how it may be developed. To cater for participants' working day, some Guides will meet with participants as early as 8 a.m. and as late as 8.30 p.m.

The week begins on the afternoon of Sunday 11th June with an hour-long meeting for all Guides and participants. This gives an opportunity for introductions, general guidance on prayer to help participants get started and for initial conversations. At the end of the week everyone meets again to reflect on and to celebrate their experience of the week. Please contact Fr. Patrick if you would like to know more.
