### Dying and Rising

Next week is the holiest week of the Christian year. During it we celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus - God the Father's plan that death unfolds into life. The death of God's son led to his resurrection, and his death will lead to our resurrection as well. God's plan also pervades our daily lives and experiences - not only our spiritual lives. Hence Jesus had no trouble in finding illustrations from daily life for what we call the Paschal Mystery. From his observations of nature he declared, 'Unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains a grain of wheat. But if it dies it produces much fruit.' (Today's Gospel reading)

We come into contact with the Paschal Mystery for the first time with our baptism where, as St. Paul says, we are baptised into Christ's death that we might live in newness of life. Every time we participate in the Mass we do so in memory of Christ's death and resurrection. We say this out loud at each Mass immediately after the bread and wine have been consecrated as the Body and Blood of Christ. And once a year we celebrate this saving mystery of our faith in the *Triduum* services of Holy Week on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. Our celebration of this great truth is all the more moving if these beautiful and thought-provoking liturgies are well attended!

This evening at 6.00 pm there will be a reflective service using readings and music from the Taizé community in France.

#### Holy Week and Easter Services

We are fast-approaching Holy Week and Easter, and this year the Maundy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper (on 29th March) with watch until midnight will take place here at Holy Trinity at 8.00 pm. **We need six people from Holy Trinity to volunteer to have their feet ceremonially washed during this service.**

The Good Friday liturgy will be here at 3.00 pm and the Easter Vigil will be a joint celebration at Holy Innocents on Saturday 31st March at 8.00 pm. There is a separate leaflet available detailing all the services in our parishes for Holy Week and Easter, please put these dates in your diary and make being at these 'Triduum' services a priority.

#### Ecumenical Pilgrimage to Walsingham

On Saturday 14th April we shall be going on pilgrimage to Walsingham with some of our neighbouring churches. Leaving Holy Innocents at 8.00 am, we shall arrive at the Catholic shrine for the noon Mass, and then go to the village for sprinkling, Anglican Mass and devotions during the afternoon. Pilgrims will need to bring a packed lunch or purchase lunch locally. A hot meal at 5.00 pm will be included in the cost of £30, and we should arrive back about 9.00 pm.
