The Great Week

The Palm Sunday procession today begins our celebration of a series of events which God the Father ordained would accomplish our salvation. Holy Week was once called the Great Week. It begins with the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem and culminates in the three days we call the 'Triduum': Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday. On Thursday evening (already Friday by Jewish liturgical reckoning) Jesus prefigures his final act of sacrificial love at the Last Supper. On the Friday Jesus offered the sacrifice of himself on the cross, whilst on the Saturday, when we reflect on Jesus' burial and decent to the dead, we remember that his death was real, and no fiction.



The Mass which ends the Easter Vigil service after dark on the Saturday (by now Sunday in Jewish reckoning) reminds us we cannot separate Jesus' death from his resurrection. The meaning of these three great holy days of our faith is not something lost in the past, but a reality for us in every celebration of the Holy Eucharist. 'We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection until you come again.'

Holy Week and Easter Services

This year the Maundy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper (on 29th March) with watch until midnight will take place here at Holy Trinity at 8.00 pm. **We need six people from Holy Trinity to volunteer to have their feet ceremonially washed during this service.** The Good Friday liturgy will be here at 3.00 pm and the Easter Vigil will be a joint celebration at Holy Innocents on Saturday 31st March at 8.00 pm. There is a separate leaflet available detailing all the services in our parishes for Holy Week and Easter, please put these dates in your diary and make being at these 'Triduum' services a priority.
