Keeping in Touch

Next month a new piece of legislation called the General Data Protection Regulation comes into effect. All organisations (including churches) will have to comply with some very strict guidelines about how information like names and addresses is stored and used. This means that if you want Holy Trinity church to be able to contact you, for example to send information or reminders about services and events, you need to actively consent to this. To comply with the law we need everyone to complete and return a 'consent form', available at the back of church, and return it to the box provided.
