### Peace be with you!

Today, one week after Easter Day, we hear the risen Jesus' greeting to his disciples 'Peace be with you.' One way Jesus offers us that peace is through the forgiveness of our sins. This happens through the ministry of the church in three ways. Through baptism we are washed clean of sins, whether we are baptised as an infant or an adult. Through our taking a full, conscious and active participation in the Mass we acknowledge our sinfulness and ask for God's mercy and when we make use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession) we hear the comforting voice of Christ, 'I absolve you from your sins.'



On the night of his resurrection, having triumphed over sin and death, Jesus granted his church this gift of forgiveness, so that the power of his life, healing and love might penetrate our lives. This is indeed the gift of a real peace which passes all understanding.

### Electoral Roll and APCM

Our Annual parochial Church Meeting will take place this year after Mass on Sunday 29th April. At it we hear reports from our church officers and elect our Churchwardens and Parochial Church Council for the next twelve months. To be able to vote, or to stand for election, you must be on the church Electoral Roll. (The Electoral Roll is the nearest thing we have to a list of church membership). If you are not on it, or if your contact details have changed recently, please complete an application form available at the back of church. We hold the annual meeting over a bite to eat, so any contributions of food for it would be gratefully received.

### Keeping in Touch

Next month a new piece of legislation comes into effect which means that all organisations (including churches) that hold information about people (like names and addresses) have to comply with some very strict guidelines about how this information is stored and used. In a nutshell this means that if you want Holy Trinity church to be able to contact you, for example to send information or reminders about services and events, you need to actively consent to this. To comply with the law we need everyone to complete and return a 'consent form' which you were given with this newsletter, and return it to the box at the back of church.
