### Let it begin with me

The Letter of James in the New Testament contains great deal of insightful and practical advice about living the Christian life. Today he reminds us that war and conflict have their origins in the conflicts inside us as human beings. James also tells us that those who work for peace sow seeds which bear fruit in holiness. Often we look for solutions to problems and conflicts outside ourselves. James is telling us rather to look within, and then we might be able to be those who can help others. As the words of the well-known song have it: *Let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me.*
