### God's Spirit

The overall theme of the readings at Mass this Sunday is *God's Spirit in the world*, and each of them reflects on it in a different way. We praise God for all his prophets: men and women of every generation who have resisted evil and manifested the Spirit in their lives. Today, very appropriately, we celebrate a baptism during the Mass, and many of the prayers used during the baptism service reflect this calling. Why not listen out particularly for the relevant words as they are said. The prayers are for the person being baptised but after all, they apply to each and every one of us who are already baptised.
