

An historic commemoration



This year Remembrance Sunday, Armistice Day and the 100th anniversary of the ending of World War One all fall on the same day - Sunday 11th November. We had hoped that the war memorial on the green outside Holy Trinity would have been restored in time for this significant date, but nevertheless we will be marking the anniversary with a special outdoor service of remembrance at the war memorial at 10.55 am that day. This will include readings, prayers and the customary two-minute silence at 11.00 am precisely.

After laying a wreath at the war memorial we will go back into church for the Sunday Mass which will be one of requiem for all the war dead. **Please note this means that the Sunday Mass will be starting nearly half an hour earlier than usual that day.** It would be good if as many people as possible came to the Act of Remembrance and the Mass to honour all who have died in the service of their country, and to pray for peace on this historic occasion.
