### AMDG - Another Way

Today's gospel reading at Mass gives us another way of taking up our cross and following Jesus - that of service. So often the way of the world is to be ambitious for promotion, prestige and power - all for self-glorification. The way of the cross is to serve others with humble love as Jesus did. He came 'not to be served, but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many.' Many in our congregation, and others, willingly sacrifice their own time and energies to help others. Perhaps it is by caring for a sick or elderly relative or friend - perhaps it is by giving generously of their time to help others in the community through running our projects in the church hall. They deserve thanks and recognition.

Of course helping others can bring its own rewards, but we are called to do things for the greater glory of God. That is the meaning of Latin letters AMDG which head the dedication plaque near the kitchen hatch in the refurbished Groves Room. *Ad majorem Dei gloriam* - To the greater glory of God.

There will be a choir practice at 6.00 pm at Holy Innocents on 2nd November for anyone who would like to sing in the Fauré Requiem. #### Remembrance Sunday 11th November - Service time Change

This year Remembrance Sunday, Armistice Day and the 100th anniversary of the ending of World War One all fall on the same day - Sunday 11th November. We will mark the occasion with an outdoor act of remembrance at 10.55 am that day at the war memorial, and then go back into church for the Sunday Mass which will be one of requiem for all the war dead.

**Please note this means that the Sunday Mass will be starting nearly half an hour earlier than usual that day.**
