All Saints and All Souls

This week sees two important commemorations in our church year. On the feast of All Saints on Thursday we celebrate God's love and victory in the lives of countless men and women who have lived the gospel fully - often to the extent of giving their lives for it. The following day, All Souls, is a opportunity to remember at Mass our departed loved ones who are journeying towards the fullness of life in God's kingdom. We give thanks for the way those who have gone before us (whether recognized officially as saints or not) have influenced us for good, and pray that we may be more faithful to the promises made in baptism to reject sin and follow Christ.

There will be an additional Mass for the feast of All Saints at Holy Trinity at noon on Thursday 1st November, and the 7.00 pm Mass at Holy Innocents will be sung that day. We will commemorate All Souls (the faithful departed) with a full Sung Mass of Requiem (Fauré) at Holy Innocents at 7.30 pm on Friday 2nd November. There will be a choir practice at 6.00 pm at Holy Innocents on 2nd November for anyone who would like to sing in the Fauré Requiem. We will also be making the Tuesday evening Mass at Holy Trinity on 6th November one of Requiem.
