Remembrance Sunday 11th November

Given the great significance of Remembrance Sunday this year, our Sunday Mass today is one of requiem for all the war dead, and we have special readings for this today. At the heart of each Mass is an act of remembrance - that of the sacrifice of Jesus himself on the cross - a sacrifice for the forgiveness of sins and the reconciliation of humankind with God. How appropriate it is then that we celebrate a Mass of Requiem for all killed as a result of armed conflict, and remember those who paid the ultimate price of their lives for our freedom. Today's commemoration also reminds us very powerfully of the need of God's forgiveness for the human greed, pride and folly which can lead to loss of life on such a huge scale in warfare. May all those killed in armed conflict rest in peace.

At 6.00 pm this evening there will be the devotion of Stations of the Cross at Holy Innocents offered in remembrance of the fallen.
