Remembrance Sunday 11th November - Service Time Change

This year Remembrance Sunday, Armistice Day and the 100th anniversary of the ending of World War One all fall on the same day - Sunday 11th November. We will mark the occasion with an act of remembrance at 10.55 am that day at the war memorial on the green, and then go back into church for the Sunday Mass which will be one of requiem for all the war dead.



Please note this means that the Sunday Mass at Holy Trinity will be starting nearly half an hour earlier than usual next Sunday.

Also at 6.00 pm that day there will be the devotion of Stations of the Cross offered in remembrance of the fallen.

November Mass of Requiem for our Dead
