Joyful waiting

Advent resets the clocks and calendars of Christian worship as we move into another cycle of prayer, liturgy and scripture. Autumn ends and Winter begins. The season calls us to a new beginning, with God's great mercy and compassion framing yet another year for us. Our tradition proclaims this as both an event already accomplished, and an event moving towards fulfilment in the future - our future.

We live in the in-between period of human salvation. between the two comings: the first was when Christ came to Bethlehem giving us the opportunity and power to receive him: his second coming will be when he comes again to take his Bride the Church at the end of time. This is the heart of the tension of Advent, waiting in expectancy since Christ risen from the dead and now present among us in mystery will he revealed to everyone on the Last Day as the glorious son of our heavenly father. We wait, with joy. and pray in hope trusting in his power to save us. It is our Christian hope that makes Advent a time of joyful waiting.

Advent Sunday at Holy Trinity

As usual we shall be holding our Advent service this evening at 6.00 pm. The service will be followed by mulled wine and mince pies. Any donation of mince pies for the occasion will be gratefully received.

Advent Prayer Tree

A small 'Advent tree' has been placed at the back of church. Unlike a Christmas tree it will not be decorated, but small la-

bels are available for people to write the names of the people or the things they will be praying for in Advent (anonymously if liked). These can be hung on the tree which will be moved into the sanctuary at Christmas.
