From now on...



'From now on it is people you will catch,' says Jesus to Peter when he calls him from his job as a fisherman. The miraculous catch of fish prefigures the mission of the church. Labouring on their own, the fishermen had caught nothing. Directed by the word of the Lord, the catch of fish was enormous. This incident reminds us that the mission of the church relies on human effort in co-operation with the Divine. Saint Paul, in our second reading today, relates how it was the grace of God, working in him, that enabled him to do what he did, and that energized his mission.
