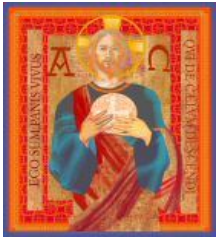

A Lent of Accompanied Prayer



Lent begins on Ash Wednesday 6th March, and during this season there will be an opportunity for anyone from our Hornsey churches who wants to grow in prayer to get some help, support and advice. Participants are asked to try and pray for a time each day, and to meet for half an hour or so with a Prayer Guide

once a week - here at Holy Trinity this will probably be on Sunday afternoons.

The Prayer Guides are men and women from various denominations - some lay, some ordained - all of whom have been trained to help others pray. They will listen, offer advice, suggest different ways of praying, and generally encourage each participant in his or her prayer life.

There is no charge (although any donation towards expenses would be gratefully received) and the Lent of Accompanied Prayer begins with a meal together on Monday evening 4th March at Hornsey Parish Church. Please pick up one of the leaflets at the back of church, or speak to Fr. Patrick if you would like to know more.

New Electoral Roll

Every six years all Church of England parishes have to prepare a completely new Electoral Roll. The Electoral Roll is the nearest thing there is to a list of people who would say they are members of Holy Trinity Church. If you worship here (even if only occasionally) your name should be on it. Being on the Roll entitles you to vote at the annual meeting and stand for election to a church office. All existing members of the electoral roll will need to complete a form. Please complete and return one of the forms at the back of church, whether or not you are already on it.
