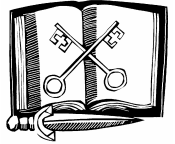

The Lord who empowers



On the face of it Peter and Paul, the two saints we celebrate today, were unlikely candidates for the roles of leadership they held in the early Church. One was an impetuous fisherman, the other a persecutor of early Christians. Yet the crucial factor which enabled each to fulfill God's will and purposes was God's grace. We hear Jesus tell Peter that it was not 'flesh and blood' which revealed the insights he had about Jesus, but God himself. Paul proclaims that it was the Lord who stood by him and gave him the power to do the things he did.

This is why today's feast should encourage us all. It reminds us of what God can do with us and all his disciples if we, who are ordinary flesh and blood, are open to his will.
