Ambassadors

An ambassador is a person who serves as a representative or envoy of a ruler. An ambassador of Jesus Christ is any person who seeks to live and work to His praise and glory in daily life. Any one of us is called to represent Jesus Christ in our daily lives. St Paul writes to the Corinthians: "We are therefore Christ's ambassadors as though God were making his appeal through us." However, people can be a bit unsure or hesitant about sharing their faith for all sorts of good reasons, so to help us think a bit more about this, Rev Nigel Taylor, who is the Edmonton Area Director of Ministry, will be coming to Holy Trinity on Sunday 17th November to preach about this, and to lead a discussion after the 11.30 Mass. It will be a good opportunity to learn how to become more confident in speaking and living the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
