Important advice from the diocese about current public health concerns

While it is our faith that the sacraments are means of grace and not of sickness, they are physically ministered and received, and we should all pay careful attention to hygiene. Those giving communion have been asked to wash and sanitize their hands before doing so.

Those receiving communion are asked not to intinct (dip the bread into the wine). If you feel ill, please consider receiving the host only, and not from the chalice. It is Anglican teaching that to receive the sacrament in one kind only (ie. just the bread) is to receive the sacrament in its entirety.

There is no need to refrain from sharing the Peace, unless you have cold or flu-like symptoms.
